OVERVIEW

This course is aligned to CSTF Level 2 and covers adult and paediatric Basic Life Support, including AED and anaphylaxis. It is aimed at anyone working in a healthcare environment who requires an understanding of the recognition and management of a deteriorating patient, including anaphylaxis and of a cardiac arrest. The course has been developed in line with Resuscitation Council (UK) guidelines.

OBJECTIVES

At the end of the course, the learner will be able to:

- Understand individual roles and responsibilities, current legislation and local resuscitation policies and procedures, including the Do Not Attempt Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Policy
- Recognise cardiorespiratory arrest and know how to summon help
- Recognise and respond to patients with clinical deterioration
- Initiate an appropriate management of a choking patient and to use the recovery position
- Provide basic airway management; initiate and maintain effective chest compressions and lung ventilations and operate an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) safely
- Define the term anaphylaxis, understand the causes, recognise and diagnose anaphylaxis using the ABCDE approach and administer the treatment for anaphylaxis
