OVERVIEW

This Immediate Life Support course (covering both adults and paediatrics) includes the recognition and management of the deteriorating patient including anaphylaxis, management of a cardiac arrest within a team, the use of an AED and the use of airway adjuncts including the use of positive pressure ventilation.

OBJECTIVES

At the end of the course, the learner will be able to:

- Demonstrate an understanding of the ABCDE approach to assess a patient
- Recognise and manage a Seriously Ill Child or Adult
- Provide effective Basic Life Support for adults and paediatrics
- Demonstrate an understanding of being able to recognise and manage sedation related complications
- Demonstrate the use of deployable airway competencies (including basic airway manoeuvres, the use of airway adjuncts and the ability to administer positive pressure ventilation).
- Demonstrate the safe and appropriate use of an automated external defibrillator
